GABRIELA New York is named in honor of Gabriela Silang, a revolutionary heroine during the Spanish colonization of the Philippines in the mid-1700s. Following her husband Diego's assassination in 1763, Gabriela led their forces in revolt against the Spanish in Ilocos Sur. Her name has since then become synonymous to describing any strong Filipina fighting against injustice and oppression.

GABRIELA also stands for General Assembly Binding Women for Reforms, Integrity, Equality, Leadership, and Action.

GABRIELA New York (formerly Filipinas for Rights and Empowerment) is a mass-based women's organization serving New York City and its surrounding areas. We connect the Filipino diaspora to the women's struggle in the Philippines. We are women of Philippine descent, including those who are migrants, immigrants and US-born. We recognize Filipino women of mixed heritage and adoptees. GABRIELA New York is a LGBTQIGNC friendly organization that is inclusive of transgender people of Philippine descent.


